What they do depends on the needs of the client; they provide the opportunity to have a cup of tea and a chat or play Scrabble and do a crossword. They may join sports activities, such as taking someone out and playing a round of golf. Go shopping, to a garden centre, or just sit and listen. The good thing about this service is that we can provide exactly what the client needs.

Our service is available 7 days per week (including bank holidays). A Befriender can be arranged from a minimum of 1 hour to as often as you like; as a one off or on a regular basis.
