


Activities

It is vital that residents keep active mentally and physically to make the most of every day. They are encouraged to maintain leisure interests and hobbies, and are given the opportunity of joining in with activities by our Activities Coordinator.



Activities include: handicrafts, games and puzzles, quizzes, visiting speakers, live performances, tea parties, religious observance services and other local community events.

A variety of days out are organised and various other musical events scheduled. There is a greenhouse on site and a large raised bed allowing residents to do some gardening if they wish. There is a library facility which can supply large print books, talking books and newspapers, taking into account choice and ability.



Facilities

Residents can relax and participate in the life of the house. There is a large, bright living room with a TV and stereo equipment (and with doors leading to a sensory garden), a dining room, a sensory room and a multid denominational chapel with a weekly service. Most of the rooms have peaceful views across the main garden which is wheelchair accessible.



LONG TERM CARE FOR INDIVIDUALS

The House

St. Edmund's House is designed to provide 24 hour care to 8 people over 18 years of age with a physical or sensory disability. The atmosphere is welcoming and friendly, supported by well-trained staff able to meet the special needs of each individual.

The House aims to care for people who are highly physically dependent; many will be wheelchair users needing assistance with activities of daily living. The House is specifically designed to meet the needs of service users with a diagnosis of a chronic progressive or static neurological condition, cancers or degenerative conditions.

Care Provided

Nursing care in St. Edmund's is provided on an individual basis within a calm, comfortable, safe, homely environment. Staff are trained to exceptionally high standards to ensure all residents are cared for in a friendly and professional manner. Each individual is treated as one, ensuring their privacy is respected at all times, their dignity is maintained and each individual choice of lifestyle is not infringed upon or discriminated against, regardless of age, ethnicity, sex, country of origin, disability or religious belief.

Residents are registered with the local medical centre and have two booked doctor's visits per week; additional visits can be arranged should they be required. Local out-of-hour's medical cover is provided along with specialist nurses, physiotherapists, speech and language therapists and a dietician.

All bedrooms are single rooms which are tastefully furnished. Most have en-suite facilities. Every room has a telephone point and internet connection and meets stringent fire and safety regulations. Residents are encouraged to make their room their home with personal effects and small items of furniture and other treasured possessions.

There is a daily choice of menu; all produce is locally sourced, freshly prepared and cooked on the premises. Special diets are catered for. Light refreshments such as tea, coffee, soft drinks and nutritional snacks are available throughout the day and night on request and there are beverage making facilities in the dining room.

The House has an open visiting policy, welcoming visitors and pets throughout the day.
